The District Police Bahawalpur



Background

The National College of Business Administration and Economics (NCBA&E), is a private university in, Pakistan. Its main campus is located in Lahore and sub-campuses are situated in Multan, Bahawalpur, and Rahimyar. It was ranked 25th in Punjab province and 57th in the "Business Schools" category in Pakistan, while it was ranked 2nd in the "Business Schools" category, in Punjab. Founded in 1994. NCBA&E is offering multiple disciplines and career programs like: professional certifications, undergraduate studies, graduate studies, and postgraduate courses.

Mission:

The National College of Business Administration and Economics (NCBA&E) aims to fulfill the academic needs of students who want to pursue their education in management and scientific fields of study. The university has clear objectives to groom their students both academically and ethically and to produce personalities with competent moral and professional qualities. The programs are designed to fulfill their requisites qualifications in various disciplines. Currently, the National College of Business Administration & Economics (NCBA&E) is providing quality higher education to students across Bahawalpur Region, with a commitment to promoting social responsibility and community engagement. The institution is dedicated to shaping future leaders who contribute meaningfully to society, equipped with both academic knowledge and practical experience. As part of its mission, NCBA&E seeks to collaborate with local government entities to create synergies between academic excellence and real-world governance, administrative, and management challenges.

Introduction

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the National College of Business Administration & Economics (NCBA&E) and the District Police aims to open new opportunities for students to engage with real community issues and also provide government employees and their children with access to higher education through valuable fee concessions. For government employees, flexible class timings are available on both weekdays and weekends. Moreover, this partnership facilitates academic and practical learning, enabling students to gain real-life experience through community-based projects and interactions with district police leadership. The collaboration also strengthens the bond between education and governance, promoting mutual growth and understanding. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed by the District Police Officer, Bahawalpur, and was also further referred to the other aligned departments of the district police.

OBJECTIVES

The objective of this MoU is comprised of the following grounds: -

- NCBA&E agrees to offer tuition fee concessions to employees of the District Police Bahawalpur and their children, thereby promoting higher education accessibility for public sector families.
- NCBA&E students will have the opportunity to engage in community service projects in collaboration with the District Police. These projects will allow students to apply their academic knowledge to real-world challenges within the local community, contributing to its sustainable development.
- Students of NCBA&E will have structured opportunities to interact with heads of the
 District Police Departments to gain a deeper understanding of governance, decisionmaking processes, and the functioning of local government institutions. This interaction
 will include guest lectures, internships, visits to district offices, and research on
 management and administrative issues of the police organization.
- The MoU shall be initially for two years, starting from the date of signing, and will be extendable.

MEMORANDUM

This MoU constitutes a formal agreement between NCBA&E and District Police Officer Bahawalpur. Both parties agree to collaborate on the following initiatives

Fee Concession Program: NCBA&E will offer a specific percentage of fee concessions, up to 40 %, to all government employees of District Police Bahawalpur and their children upon admission to its programs. This initiative aims to promote higher education and skill development among the families of government employees. Moreover, NCBA&E will also offer a 50 % discount to the family of a Police Shuhada.

Student Engagement in Community Projects: The District Police Bahawalpur will facilitate NCBA&E students in participating in community-driven projects aligned with local development goals. Projects may include public safety campaigns, crime prevention awareness, youth mentoring programs, and other initiatives designed to benefit the community. These projects will provide students with hands-on experience in addressing real-life community issues under the guidance of both NCBA&E faculty and District Police officials.

Governance Awareness Programs: The District Police Bahawalpur will organize and facilitate comprehensive governance awareness programs for NCBA&E students, providing them with opportunities to engage in interactive sessions with senior police officials, participate in workshops and discussions on governance practices and decision-making processes, and gain insights into the administrative and operational aspects of law enforcement through structured visits to police stations and departmental offices. These programs aim to enhance students' understanding of governance frameworks, encourage civic responsibility, and foster a deeper appreciation of the role of law enforcement.

Internship Programs

NCBA&E and the District Police Bahawalpur will jointly establish internship programs for students. Internships will provide students with practical exposure to police administration, including public service delivery, community engagement, and organizational human resource management.
